Thanks to YOU, your Community Arts Center of Cambria County not only met its 2020 Sustaining Fund Drive goal of \$35,000 for the third year in a row, but surpassed it with over \$50,000 raised. During a year of uncertainty and significant changes, YOUR generosity made a substantial impact to the cultural life of our community. This year's 20th anniversary Sustaining Fund Drive 2021 will have a goal of \$40,000.

We are thrilled to be celebrating 53 years as a cultural hub of artistic excellence in Cambria County. Everyone has been affected by COVID-19, and it is with overjoyed excitement that we are announcing wonderful 2021 "in-person" programs, events, and fundraisers beginning in June. This will include our American Girl Doll Family-A-Fair, Log Art Theatre productions, Great American Auction, Rosie's Bookapalooza (including used book sale), Murder Mystery Dinner Theatre, Celebrating a Legacy recognition awards, A Jimmy Stewart Christmas, 51st Holly Bazaar, and the long awaited, 50th anniversary Log House Arts Festival.

The Arts Center serves the community through initiatives that foster positive artistic outlets, offer quality educational experiences, promote outreach inclusion, and provide free programs for all members of the community. Where your support this year will be the most impactful is for our *free* offerings, such as ARToberFEST, Coffee House Series, Concerts-on-the-Green (pending), Exhibitions, Arty Parties, Bright Star Theatre Touring children's productions, art gatherings and demonstrations, more scholarships for Summer Arts Camps, along with free admission to the Holly Bazaar and Log House Arts Festival. Additionally, the Arts Center focuses on free outreach programming through Outbound Art, which supports the blind/visually impaired and deaf/hard of hearing populations, as well as the mental health community. Your charitable dollars provide the much-needed operational support that allows these programs to continue. We ask you to continue your support or perhaps provide us with a gift for the first time. No gift is ever too small, except for the one never given.

Nonprofit organizations need their community now more than ever. According to the Americans for the Arts *COVID-19 Pandemic Impact on The Arts Research Update: May 10, 2021*, roughly two-thirds of organizations with "in-person" programming remain closed to the public with 42% lacking the financial resources needed to restart the "in-person" programming. Thanks to our community we are *not* one of these organizations. **Approximately, eighty-nine percent (89%) of the Arts Center's operational funding comes from donations throughout the year.** Your monetary contribution will promote our sustained success and ensure that YOUR Arts Center continues to grow well into the future. 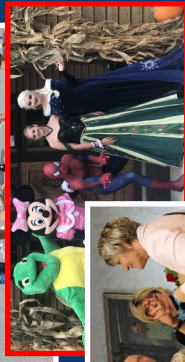
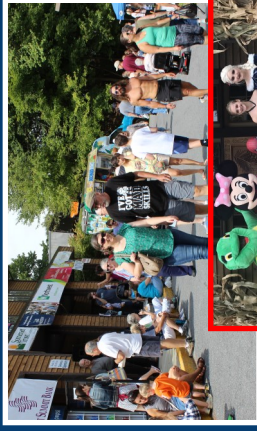


Free Music Series: Concerts-on-the-Green (Summer) and Coffee House Series (Summer/Fall).
