Baker Recognition Awards are given for Dedication to Volunteer Service and for Excellence in Teaching. Honorees receive a \$500 Cash Award and a Waterford Crystal Bowl. This generosity comes from Mrs. Wanda Baker, who established the awards in memory of her husband's service to our community. Mr. Baker was a highly respected engineer in his field, working for the Pennsylvania Electric Company from 1946 to 1984. He retired as a Vice President. In the community, he served on the Board of Directors of the Incorporators of Grandview Cemetery and as Past President of Lee Hospital Board of Directors.
