“The Community Arts Center of Cambria County is proud to announce that the M. Josephine Paul Family Museum has made leaps and bounds over the last few months. The new spaces will begin their use of occupancy during the Spring Session of classes and workshops. There will be an official grand opening and tours of the facility once more COVID-19 restrictions have been lifted, and larger indoor gatherings are permitted. We look forward to all the amazing events, programs, and artistic initiatives that our bright future holds!

“Currently, the Community Arts Center of Cambria County has embarked on its first Capital Campaign in over 30 years with a \$550,000 goal. This will provide the additional funds needed for the M. Josephine Paul Family Museum, as well as the much-needed renovations to the Goldhaber-Fend Fine Arts Center building. The expansion project was partially funded by a major gift from Josephine Paul, former Supervisor of Art for the Greater Johnstown School District. We will honor her legacy by establishing the M. Josephine Paul Family Museum, utilizing funds that we have nurtured over the past two decades. The museum is connected to the current Goldhaber-Fend Fine Arts Center building on both floors, and includes an outdoor Amphitheatre.

Did you know that a hobby like crocheting is a proven stress reliever and a positive creative outlet? More and more people are discovering the versatility of crocheting. In just a couple weeks you will learn basic stitches (chain stitch, single crochet, half double crochet, double crochet, slip stitch) that will allow you to start and finish beginner projects. To get started, you'll only need a few things: A ball or skein of cotton (sugar 'n cream)— Medium #4 worsted weight — yarn, solid colors (no dark colors to start), An aluminum size J-10 (6.0mm) and H-9 (5.5mm) crochet hooks
