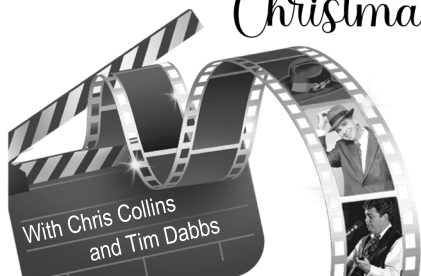

## An "Upcycled" Christmas Designed by Alan Lichtenfels
