- Sunscreen and insect repellent are strongly suggested and must be provided by the parents/guardians. CAC will not supply these items, and campers must be able to apply them independently.
- All campers **MUST** be fully potty trained in order to attend any camps at CACCC. *If a child has more than one isolated accident, CACCC reserves the right to remove the child and refuse their attendance for the remainder of camp with no refund.*
- Plan to pack a water bottle and non-refrigerated lunch/snack each day.
- All camp employees have PA Clearances.

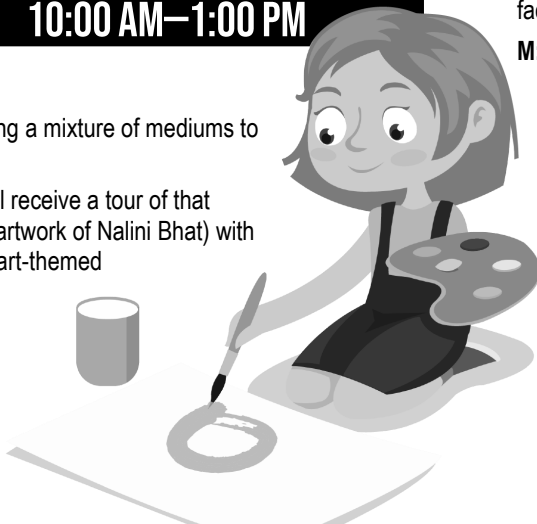

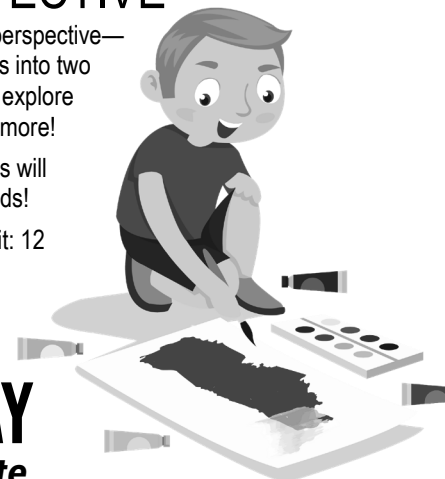
