- All work must arrive neatly packed and separated by: School, Division/Grade (First, Second, Third) and Teacher
- Complete the enclosed Summary Form in a like manner and submit with work on receiving day.
- All 2-D work must be mounted or matted with poster or illustration board.
 NO CONSTRUCTION PAPER. Framed work must be wired to be hung. Matted work will be hung with T-Pins.
- Only **ORIGINAL** recent work will be accepted. No copied photos, magazines or other artwork accepted. Crafts and 3-D work must be original and creative. If, during the exhibit, any work is found to be a copy, it will be removed and any award revoked.
- BOTH TAGS MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY! Please print information on both tags clearly in black ink. (See specifications below for 2-D vs. 3D works.) DO NOT SEPARATE Tag (A) from Tag (B). Tag (B) will be used to identify the work.
- All 2-D work must have one tag securely attached to the upper right-hand corner on the back, DO NOT SEPARATE Tag (A) from Tag (B). Tag (B) will be used to identify the work.
- All 3-D work should have one tag securely attached to the base and the other tag mounted on cardboard and attached securely with string to work.
- If meeting the above criteria, all work submitted by the teacher will be displayed. Please allow time when delivering work to have it checked.
