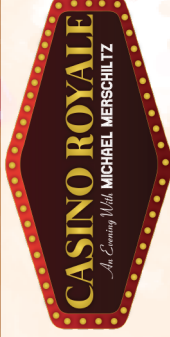
ARSENIC & OLD LACE
