The High Country Watermedia Society, Inc. provides monetary awards for the advancement of the visual arts to non-profit programs and schools on an annual basis in the spring. The endowment fund from which these awards are granted is held and managed by the NC Community Foundation (NCCF), a 501(C)3 organization.

Grant proposals must be post-marked by **March 15 of each year**. The Grant Review Committee will consider eligible proposals and determine grant awards. Proposals may be awarded in full or in part; awarded with contingencies; or may be declined. Grant recipients will be informed of the decision made by the Grants Committee by April 15.

All North Carolina counties represented in the society's membership are eligible to apply.
