Surface: 10x10 or 12 x 12 <u>Cradled Wood Board</u> (or <u>Canvas</u>). I'll be using a wood board. For the sake of time, please Pre-Gesso your surfaces. I'll demonstrate on a gray background made with white gesso and a touch of carbon black.

Acrylic Paints: Acrylic Fluid paints or Soft Body acrylics.

I consider the following colors basics that are always on my palette regardless of what I am painting: Titanium White, Titan Buff, Carbon Black, Azo Gold, a brown like Raw Umber or Van Dyke Brown., and a Blue such as Payne's Gray or Prussian Blue. Here's a link to <u>Golden Fluid</u> and <u>Liquitex Basics</u> or <u>Liquitex Professional Soft Body</u>

My limited Palette will consist of: **My basic palette listed above for mixing**, and an analogous color palette of blues & green: (Manganese Blue, Ultramarine blue, plus blues listed in basic palette; and Hansa Yellow and Cad Yellow, Napthol Red).

Note-feel free to pick any colors you like for your limited palette. Just stick with 5-6 besides your basic mixing colors.

Glazing Medium (I prefer Satin).

Matte Medium

Catalyst Scraper

Silicone Scraper

Assorted Brushes: Here are a couple that are perfect for those new to acrylics. <u>Princeton</u> & <u>Blick</u>. I like to have a mix of large-small brushes in both flat and round. Here's an option for a larger <u>flat brush</u>.

Paper: A Couple of Sheets of Watercolor <u>Paper</u> for Samples & Studies.

Drawing tools: Neocolor II Crayons, Grease Pencil in Black, Stabilo Woody, Colored pencils (whatever you have)

Optional: Fineline Applicator with white or black fluid paint in it., Deli Paper, Stencils

Paper Towels

Paint Palette (my go to palette for every day work). & Palette Paper

After you partake in the course, you may decide to get a few things or you may decide that something wasn't for you, so just play along and not stress about having exactly what is here.
