2. Negotiations Update

- a. Scheduled date with administration for exchanging proposals 3/14 instead of meeting for Teacher Liaison
- b. Budget meeting with Steve and JoAnne March 19 @ 3:30, CTE Room A 116 - all members are welcome to attend they will review how the BOCES budget works
- c. Some members have tried pressuring Union board members to share proposals this is not common practice. Issue can be due to us not having met with the BOCES and it could be leaked to admin and change their proposal, also could have the proposal opened up to the community not just BOCES, pressuring the negotiation team. Even in NYSUT offices they don't share proposals until contracts are finalized.
- d. Not sharing overall protects the safety of the negotiations process
- e. Greece got an average of 16% wage increase had to give up their step system and buy people out of the steps in order to get this. (averaged to 3.2%/year once accounted for buying people out).

- f. Brockport got an 11% raise but they were far behind starting salaries compared to other districts- Admin had to bump current members up enough to raise the starting salaries.
- g. Currently we have a cap at 10 years plus starting salary this is a change that administration needs to make. Most districts don't have this cap.
