The health of players, members, team officials, Management Committee members, Committee members, visitors and spectators is of primary concern to St Pauls Uniting Sporting Club Inc (the Association). It is acknowledged that skin cancer is a major public health problem in Australia. It is recognized that skin cancer is preventable and like any other medical condition, is best dealt with by the application of preventative measures.

The ultimate responsibility rests with the individual or, in the case of minors, with the parents or guardians.

The Association endeavours to provide either natural or man-made shade areas close to all fields.

The Association encourages, where practical, players, members, team officials,
Management Committee members, Committee members, visitors and spectators to wear a
hat (not baseball caps) that protect the face, ears, neck, shoulders and crown of the head.
The wearing of long-sleeved shirts with collars, sun smart material and sunglasses (EPF 10) is
also encouraged. It is strongly recommended that players, members, team officials,
Management Committee members, Committee members, visitors and spectators wear SPF
30+ broad spectrum sunscreen.
