





FREQUENTLY ASKED

Q: Do you offer a warranty?

A: Tridel Construction offers a two year warranty on labor as many products come with their own warranty. In most cases a warranty becomes void if the homeowner moves within the warranty time frame. However, with Tridel Construction the warranty stays with the project site rather than the owner, remaining active for the full two years despite new ownership. *Just be sure to hang on to that warranty certificate.



Q: How soon can you start a job?

A: Though it depends on several factors, we have many crews ready to start projects round the clock.

Factors include:

- Does the project require plans?
- If so, have they been drawn up?
- Do permits need to be pulled?
- If so, what jurisdiction? -Each jurisdiction has a different timeline.

• How big is the project? -A powder room remodel with updated tile, sink, and paint will take far less time than a full bathroom remodel removing a built in tub and enlarging a shower. • Are all materials readily available?

- For

multiple projects within a home, will they coincide with one another or will they occur in phases?

• If not, what is the timeline of availability?

Q: If my project requires plans and permits, but I do not want to obtain plans or submit permits, can you still do the job?

A: Tridel Construction will let you know if you need plans to proceed with the desired project. If required, Tridel Construction will not proceed with a remodel project by cutting corners and eliminating necessary steps.

Clients do have the option to obtain plans on their own that we can use to submit to the city for a building permit. Clients are also offered the option to obtain plans through our Tridel Construction.

We currently offer a plans discount. Plans must be paid in full, typically split 50/50 between a deposit and final payment. If you choose to move forward with Tridel Construction for the remodel project 50% of the plans you purchased will be deducted from the remodel estimate/contract.

Once the plans are approved and the contract for remodel is signed, we will submit to the city for a building permit.

Once approved, all inspections will be handled by Tridel Construction leaving the client worry free.



The easiest part of remodel is deciding to finally do it! Even then, that can take much time and consideration before committing. Once it has been confirmed, where do you start?

Tridel Construction will outline helpful steps within the planning phase of remodel that should come just after you've made your decision.

Before you begin to look for general contractors it is best to have a budget in mind. However, a budget is not just the number of what you want to spend in total. Instead of committing to a comfortable number, consider creating a minimum and maximum cost line.
