The Season of Lent

*I believe in one God,
the Father Almighty,
maker of heaven and earth
and of all things visible and invisible
And in one Lord Jesus Christ...*

...who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven...

Those are familiar words that we confess in the Nicene Creed on Sunday mornings. Jesus comes down from heaven and takes on human flesh. He becomes one of us, for us, in order to save us. This phrase will serve as the theme of our Lenten Midweek services as we reflect upon what it means that Jesus becomes man for us, and how He has brought us salvation through the Cross of Calvary.

On February 18th, we celebrated Ash Wednesday, which marks the first day of the Season of Lent. We began our Ash Wednesday Service with the Imposition of Ashes. Ashes, mixed with a little olive oil, were drawn into the shape of a cross on the foreheads of those who desired to receive them. We then heard those familiar words that God first spoke to Adam after he sinned: *“Remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return”* (*Genesis 3:19*). But the cross on our foreheads reminds us of the work that Jesus completed for us by dying and rising to save us. They also remind us of our baptism, when we received the sign of the cross “on our forehead and on our heart to mark us as one redeemed by Christ the Crucified.”

The Ash Wednesday service continued with the Divine Service as we hear how God serves us with His gifts through His Word and His Sacraments. Christ gives Himself for us as He feeds us with His Body and Blood for the forgiveness of our sins.

In the Wednesdays to come, we will look at why Jesus came among us as a human. We will learn how everything that Jesus does, He does for us. We will see how Jesus continues to seek us out, and saves us from sin, death, and the devil.

Join us on Wednesdays through the end of March at 6:00 pm for Soup Supper, followed by church at 7:00 pm as we see all that Jesus has done For Us!


