



Lenten Journey

You and I are about to embark upon a journey. As Moses and Israel spent 40 years wandering in the wilderness awaiting their entrance into the promised land, and as Jesus spent 40 days being tempted by Satan before beginning His earthly ministry, so the Church spends 40 days in Lent, looking forward to our own redemption.

This journey of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, which is February 14th this year. On a day typically associated with romantic love, we will gather together to remember the greatest love that the world has ever known. Ash Wednesday is a day that we remember the words that God spoke to Adam after he fell into sin: “*You are dust, and to dust you shall return*” (*Genesis 3:19*). Because we are sinners, death awaits us all. But even as God condemned Adam and Eve and all their descendants to death, He also promised that He would grant us salvation. Jesus came to bring us salvation by loving us so much that He willingly endured death to defeat death for us.

During Lent, our worship services will become increasingly somber. We will sing our last “Alleluias” on Transfiguration Sunday, which is February 11th, and will not sing it again until we celebrate the Resurrection of Our Lord. Beginning in Lent, the color of our paraments will change to purple, reminding us of our need to repent our sins. We also will no longer sing the Hymn of Praise. Our joy will be muted, even as we know that our redemption awaits us following that journey.

But even in the midst of this Lenten Season, we have reason for hope: For Christ has come to defeat sin, death, and the devil for us and for our salvation. He has carried our sins and borne our iniquities so that we who are called Children of God would receive life and salvation through His death and resurrection.

Our Midweek Lenten Series will explore the Old Testament background for the Lord’s Supper. We will read through Luther’s *Small Catechism* on The Lord’s Supper and hear how the Old Testament foreshadows Jesus’ work of giving us His own Body and Blood for our forgiveness and redemption. Please join us for our Lenten Midweek Worship Services on Wednesday evenings starting on February 14th. We will have soup supper each Wednesday at 6:00 pm, and worship will begin at 7:00 pm.
