



What is Worship: The Communion of Saints

Just about every Sunday morning when we gather for worship, we confess one of the Creeds of the Church. When we use the Apostles' Creed, we confess that we believe in "the communion of the saints." On November 1st the church celebrates *All Saints Day* as we remember the saints who have gone before us and are with Christ. This year, we will celebrate *All Saints Day* on Sunday, November 5th. So, what is the communion of saints, and what do we believe about it?

In *The Small Catechism* of Martin Luther, he explains the Third Article of the Creed (about the Holy Spirit) in this way:

I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to Him; but the Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith. In the same way He calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith. In this Christian church He daily and richly forgives all my sins and the sins of all believers. On the Last Day He will raise me and all the dead and give eternal life to me and all believers in Christ.

We received the gift of faith as the Holy Spirit has called us by the Gospel. He sustains this faith through Word and the Sacraments, and we abide in His love, mercy and grace as His children. But God does not leave us alone as individual Christians to do as we please. He calls and gathers us into the Christian Church, where He nurtures and keeps us in the true faith. He brings us to a congregation - to a community of faith - where He feeds and nourishes our faith.

As we have heard throughout our newsletter series, God serves us with His gifts in the Divine Service. In the Lord's Supper, Jesus gives us His true Body and Blood for the forgiveness of our sins and to strengthen our faith. We receive the Lord's Supper within a congregation.

We are never alone when we receive the Lord's Supper. That is pretty obvious when we gather on a Sunday morning with fellow believers, but it is also true when we receive private communion in the hospital, or in times of sickness. We receive it with the communion of saints - that is, all the saints on earth and all those who have gone before us in Christ, who now rest from their labors. We gather together with those we can see and those we cannot see to receive the Lord's gifts in communion.

We see this especially as we celebrate *All Saints Day* on November 5th, we will give thanks to God for the faithful saints who have gone before us, and rejoice in the Feast to come, where all of our fellow redeemed will join together in worship to our Lord and King, Jesus Christ.

During the month of November, our Wednesday evening services will focus on the work of the Holy Spirit as we study the 3^{rd} *Article of the Creed*. Join us on Wednesdays at 6:30pm as we receive the gifts of our Lord. We will not have church on Wednesday, November 22^{nd} but will instead gather on Thursday, November 23^{rd} at 10:00am in celebration of Thanksgiving.

May God continue to bless us with His gifts to life everlasting.

The Special Voters Meeting Decision

At the Special Voters Meeting on October 22nd, Trinity Congregation decided to make an offer on the sale of the LMH building. Our bid is for \$300,000 with a cost of \$100,000 added to this amount to make the building usable for our needs. We made the decision to submit an offer after several groups did a physical walk through and a committee investigated the cost of necessary remodeling, plumbing, heating-air conditioning units and concrete issues that were of concern. A cap has been set so that the council knows what is permissible as we consider this step forward in Trinity's ministry.

Trinity is considering this property due to the need for room to expand and use for current programs that are limited in space. The location of the building for our use is ideal. The large areas in the building provide room for youth activities, congregational fellowship events, funeral receptions and Wee Disciple activities. The three lots provide much-needed parking spaces.

This is the second time in three years that this property has been on the market. Earlier we were not in a position to make an offer. Trinity has been blessed financially to be able to consider this opportunity. Wee Disciples Board of Early Childhood Education has committed to half of the down payment, up to \$50,000, if Trinity does purchase the building.

If this purchase is in the Lord's timing and is accepted it would be a big project for us to work on as a congregation. If our offer is not accepted and another buyer does not come forth our interest would be apparent, and the door may reopen. A step of faith as the pieces fall into place as we look to expand the ministry opportunities through Trinity Congregation. We can all be praying that a God pleasing outcome will be the result.
