

WEE DISCIPLES COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY HEALTH AND SAFETY PLAN

CHILDREN AND PARENTS

Assess your child each morning. Children who exhibit the following symptoms of Coronavirus (COVID-19): fever of 100F or more, loss of taste and smell, and shortness of breath. must refrain from attending school.

Child's temperature will be taken at check-in each day.

If anyone in your household has symptoms of respiratory illness (cough, fever, shortness of breath), we ask that you keep your child home until that person has been symptom free (no cough, fever, and no fever controlling medications) for 24 hours.

Masking your child's symptoms with over the counter medications is not allowed and could be grounds for dismissal.

If a child develops a cough, fever, or shortness of breath, they will be sent home. While waiting for a sick child to be picked up, caregivers will stay with the child in a room isolated from others.

If suspected exposure to virus occurs, parents agree to isolate the student and notify Wee Disciples.

Students will wash hands regularly throughout the day.

While the children are not required to wear masks throughout the day, we ask the parents to please be diligent about mask wearing when dropping off, picking up, and interacting with staff and other individuals. If you forget your mask, disposable masks are available at the check-in computer.

Social distancing is not totally possible in a day care/preschool setting; however, children will be encouraged to distance themselves from each other and stay in their own space as much as possible when eating meals.

WEE DISCIPLES STAFF

Wee Disciples staff will self-monitor their health each day and will take their temperature upon arrival at work each day.

If suspected exposure to virus occurs, staff members agree to isolate themselves and notify the school.

If anyone in a staff member's household has symptoms of respiratory illness (cough, fever, shortness of breath), the staff member is asked to remain at home until that person has been symptom free (no cough, fever, and no fever controlling medications) for 24 hours.

All staff members are trained to maintain a clean & safe environment.

All staff members will take measures to maintain a clean & safe environment by frequently washing hands.

The staff at Wee Disciples will be doing extra cleaning and sanitizing measures throughout the day throughout the entire facility.

Staff will thoroughly clean the classrooms and bathrooms at each school day's end. This includes wiping down tables, chairs, toys, manipulatives, etc.

Playground equipment requires **written parental request** for the student **NOT** to use it. It **will not be** disinfected.

ALL PERSONS INVOLVED

In the event of COVID-19 exposure at Wee Disciples, the facility will **follow the guidance of the Cascade County Health Department** and assist with contact tracing to determine whom would need to be tested based on exposure. Exposure is based on being within 6 feet of the positive person without a mask for an accumulative 15 minutes of the day. Please keep in mind that the health department may require us to close for a period of time for a deep cleaning or a facility quarantine.

When children or staff become ill, they will be required to follow specific guidelines (provided by CCHD and/or CDC) for returning to preschool or child care.

Be aware that recommendations and guidelines are changing and being updated constantly. Wee Disciples will follow the state mandates, the CCHD guidelines and procedures at all times.

In the event of a mandatory stay-at-home directive, Wee Disciples will work to provide athome packets for the preschool students during that time.

Tuition and fees are due whether or not your child attends Wee Disciples. We will not forego or refund tuition or fees because of illness, temporary stay at home directives, required quarantines, personal choice by a family to stay home, etc.
