## Abide with Us, Lord

On the Day of the Resurrection, two disciples were walking the road to Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem. As they walked, they talked about all that had happened in Jerusalem over the past few days. Jesus came and walked with them, although they didn't recognize Him. He asked them what they were talking about, and they told Him what they had seen and heard about Jesus' death and resurrection. Go ahead and read this in Luke 24:13-35.



One phrase in that reading sticks in my mind: as they approached the town of Emmaus, Jesus acted as if He was going to continue on. But the two Disciples urged Him to stay: "Abide with us, for it is toward evening and the day is now far spent." (Luke 24:29)

I think of that passage often this time of year as the evenings lengthen and the daytime dwindles. Jesus stayed with those two Disciples. He ate with them, and when "He took the bread and blessed and broke and gave it to them, their eyes were opened and they recognized Him."

The Hymn, *Abide with Me* (LSB 878) is inspired by this text. We frequently sing this hymn at our Wednesday evening service as darkness descends. In the words of that hymn, we are reminded of the Lord's presence in our life. Jesus abides with us. He remains with us. He stays with us. He is with us as the darkness deepens, when temptations come upon us, and through all the changes in life.

There is a short service in *Lutheran Service Book* called "Compline: Prayer at the Close of the Day." It starts on page 253 of LSB and works really well for family or personal devotions in the evening. One of the prayers in that service summarizes that hymn:

Abide with us, Lord, for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent. Abide with us and with Your whole Church. Abide with us at the end of the day, at the end of our life, at the end of the world. Abide with us with Your grace and goodness, with Your holy Word and Sacrament, with Your strength and blessing. Abide with us when the night of affliction and temptation comes upon us, the night of fear and despair, the night when death draws near. Abide with us and with all the faithful, now, and forever. Amen.

God provides everything that we need in life. He sustains us with His grace and mercy. He protects us from all danger. He gives us strength and blessing, even in our darkest moments. And He is there for us and with us as death draws near.

Hold Thou Thy cross before my closing eyes; Shine through the gloom, and point me to the skies. Heav'n's morning breaks, and earth's vain shadows flee; In life, in death, O Lord, abide with me. ~LSB 878:6

Abide in the peace of the Lord. He will preserve you.
