



## Forty Days: A Lenten Journey



“Yet forty days, and Ninevah shall be overthrown!” proclaimed the prophet Jonah. We will hear those words from *Jonah Chapter 3* during our Wednesday Midweek Service on February 4<sup>th</sup>. On Transfiguration Sunday (February 15<sup>th</sup>), our Old Testament Reading from *Exodus 24* will tell us that Moses spent forty days and forty nights on Mount Sinai. Then, on the First Sunday of Lent (February 22<sup>nd</sup>), we hear that after Jesus was baptized, the Spirit led Him into the wilderness where He fasted for forty days and nights before the devil came to tempt him.

The number forty appears repeatedly throughout the Bible. In the days of Noah, rains fell upon the earth for forty days and nights (*Genesis 7 and 8*). In the days of David, Goliath taunted the army of Israel for forty days in *1 Samuel 17*. Forty days is important, and so is forty years. The people of Israel wandered in the wilderness for forty years (*Numbers 14, 32*) and ate manna that entire time (*Exodus 16*). In the Book of Judges, the land had rest for forty years in the days of Othniel (*Judges 3:11*), Deborah (*Judges 5:31*), and Gideon (*Judges 8:28*). In all, there are some 50 verses in the Old Testament alone that reference “forty”, and another 16 verses in the New Testament.

If you looked up all of those Bible Verses, you would probably notice a common theme: the number forty indicates a time of trial, temptation, transition, or peace.

It should come as no surprise, then, that the Season of Lent is also forty days long. It begins on Ash Wednesday (February 18<sup>th</sup>) and ends on the day before Easter. If you pull out a calendar and count the number of days, you’ll probably say, “But that’s 46 days, not forty!” That’s true. However, Sundays do not count in the forty days of Lent. Sundays are “in Lent,” not “of Lent.”

Lent is a penitential season - a time when we reflect upon our sins and repent of the sins we commit against God and our neighbor. We rejoice that Jesus willingly sacrificed Himself for the sins of the world - for us and our salvation - to grant us forgiveness and everlasting life.

Our Lenten Midweek Series follows the theme, “**For Us.**” “**For us**” is a confession of who God is and what He brings in giving us His Son. It helps us understand why God would send His Son to die for us.

**Jesus comes for us to save us.** As God works in our lives to show us our sins, we repent as we turn away from our sins and turn back to Him. During these forty days of Lent, spend time in prayer. Repent of your sins. Seek reconciliation with whom you are in conflict. And join us for church and Bible Study.

We gather together each Sunday at 10:00am and Wednesday evening during Lent at 7:00pm. The Lord brings us together in Worship to receive His gifts in Word and Sacrament.

May the Lord use these forty days of Lent as a time of reflection on God's love shown to us in Jesus Christ. May He continue to work repentance within us, that we would receive the blessings that God has given for us through His Son.


