Top 10 Questions About the Master Class Monday Series Spring Semester 2025

Interested in taking a class at Aenon Bible College? Here are the top ten questions most often asked about the Master Class Monday Series:

- 1. How do I enroll in one or more of the Master Class Monday Series professional development courses?**

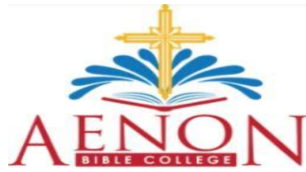
Answer: Each student must enroll in the Master Class Monday Series via online through the Aenon Bible College website: www.aenononline.com There will be an application for key information and the class you are selecting. Once you select your class, and pay the tuition, you are automatically enrolled. Students will receive a confirmation email within 24 hours. Each student will be contacted two weeks prior to class beginning by the Clinical Professor for specific details for orientation prior to the first class.

- 2. When are the professional development courses being offered?**

Answer: Students can enroll in any Master Class Monday Series starting the week of November 25, 2024. The professional development courses will be offered starting January 27, 2025, through March 14, 2025. Each Clinical Professor will determine the date and time that the specific class will meet.

- 3. Are all of the classes offered online and are all of the classes on Monday?**

Answer: All professional development classes will be offered online, and each Clinical Professor will determine the date and time of the class based upon the schedule and interest of the students in the class. Classes may be offered on days other than on Monday, based on the feedback of the class. Each professional development class will be for a total of two hours and will be offered between one and three sessions.



4. What is the cost of the class?

Answer: The cost of the class is \$99.00 plus a \$15.00 digital access fee, for a total of \$114.00. Students must pay the entire fee to be registered for the class. Students can pay with credit card, debit card, Apple pay, Google Pay, Bank E-check, or other non-cash options.

5. Can I receive academic credit for the professional development class?

Answer: Yes, all students that complete the Master Class Monday Series webinar will receive one-semester academic credit from Aenon Bible College. The one-semester credit can be applied to a certified or degree program after consulting with the Executive President of Aenon Bible College.

6. Can I take more than one class for this series?

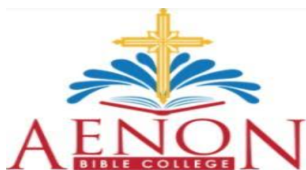
Answer: Yes, students can take as many of the Master Class Monday Series professional development classes as they wish to take. Students will need to work out individual schedules with each Clinical Professor. The Master Class Monday Series will cover a seven-week period, so multiple classes are an option based on the interest of the student.

7. Who is eligible to sign up for the three-semester hour class taught by President, Suffragan Bishop Dr. Eugene T. W. Sanders titled; “The Apostolic Pastor as Chief Executive Officer”

Answer: Pastors, District Elders, Suffragan Bishops and Bishops are eligible to sign up for the 3-semester hour class taught by President Sanders. The class will cover the entire spring semester starting on January 27, 2025, and will be completed on May 2, 2025. The class is limited to the first fifteen students who sign up and the cost of the class is \$200 per credit hour, for a total cost of \$600.00 and due prior to the start of the class. Enrollment is based on a first-come-first served basis. Tuition must be paid in full in advance prior to the first day of class. This class will be offered online with individual sessions with students.

8. Can students sign up for independent study for Master Class Monday Series class?

Answer: Students may contact their individual Clinical Professor to determine if special or customized learning sessions are an option. Each Clinical Professor has the option to determine the structure, format, time and date of class offerings, assignments, and all related academic requirements.



9. Will there be academic offerings for credit at the PAW convention in New Orleans, Louisiana during the week of July 27-August 2, 2025?

Answer: Yes, Aenon Bible College will offer several on-site classes at the 2025 Annual PAW Convention. Students will have the opportunity to sign up for classes prior to the convention and have onsite instruction, and the courses will have the option for academic credit from Aenon Bible College.
