All registered delegates (athletes, coaches, judges, and support staff) must read, sign, and submit the Informed Consent for those under 19 (EN/FR) or the Waiver for those 19+ (EN/FR). An upload link will be provided for each delegation in Bulletin #3.

Delegations are responsible for collecting medical forms from their athletes and for having them on hand at the competition should the need arise. The NBGA will NOT be collecting medical forms.
