Emergency Nonpotable Hauled Water - Application, Conditions of Approval, and Waiver/Indemnity

This program is for limited emergency household use of NONPOTABLE water, dispensed only at the District fill station. Hauled water is NOT for drinking, cooking, food preparation, or cannabis cultivation.

## Conditions of Approval and Waiver / Indemnity

This section is part of the Emergency Nonpotable Hauled Water application packet.

### 4. Conditions of Approval (if application is approved)

1. Dispensing location: Water may be obtained only from the District-designated fill station. All gallons dispensed will be metered and logged.
2. Nonpotable designation: Water dispensed under this program is NONPOTABLE. Applicant must label tanks/containers 'NONPOTABLE - DO NOT DRINK'.
3. Allowed uses: Nonpotable emergency household uses only (e.g., toilet flushing, sanitation/cleaning, fire protection).
4. Prohibited uses: Drinking/cooking/food prep; resale or distribution to other parcels; cannabis cultivation; any commercial production use.
5. Location: Water may be transported and used only within the approved Place of Use (POU): Hayfork Fire District. Use outside POU is prohibited.
6. Volume and duration: District will set a monthly gallon cap and expiration date. Exceeding the cap or expiration requires re-approval.
7. Inspections: Applicant agrees to District inspections of tank/containers and destination use as a condition of approval.
8. System protection: No connection or arrangement is allowed that could backfeed the District distribution system. Backflow protection is required at the fill station.
9. Revocation: District may revoke approval for noncompliance with these conditions, or for any misuse or misrepresentation in the application.

### 5. Waiver, Release, and Indemnity (required)

**Acknowledgement of nonpotable water.** Applicant understands and agrees that water hauled under this program is NONPOTABLE. The District does not control the cleanliness of Applicant's tanks, hoses, pumps, containers, transport, storage, or end use. Applicant will not use hauled water for drinking, cooking, food preparation, or any use that requires potable water.

**Assumption of risk.** Applicant assumes all risks of injury, illness, property damage, contamination, and loss arising from transport, storage, handling, or use of hauled water, including risks arising from Applicant's equipment or third-party hauling services.

**Release.** To the fullest extent permitted by law, Applicant releases Trinity County Waterworks District No. 1, its directors, officers, employees, agents, and volunteers from any and all claims arising from or related to Applicant's hauling, storage, handling, and use of hauled water under this program.

**Indemnity and hold harmless.** Applicant shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the District and its directors, officers, employees, agents, and volunteers from and against any claims, demands, damages, losses, liabilities, fines, penalties, and costs (including reasonable attorney fees) arising out of or related to Applicant's hauling, storage, handling, and use of hauled water under this program, including use by any third party.

**Compliance.** Applicant certifies the water will be used only as allowed in the Conditions of Approval, only within the approved POU (Hayfork Fire District), and will not be resold, traded, granted, or distributed to any other parcel or party. Applicant certifies the water will not be used for cannabis cultivation.

**Insurance.** Applicant agrees to maintain liability insurance for the hauling vehicle and to provide proof of coverage upon request. If a third-party hauler is used, Applicant is responsible for ensuring the hauler maintains appropriate coverage.
