First of all I want to let you all know that Alice and I have begun to meet on a more regular basis to discuss the overall direction and operation of Unity GT.

This is a customary practice in many Unity Centers for the President of the Board and Minister to meet usually on a weekly basis. The two meetings have had recently have been very productive and very positive.

Next, I want to share that I am very excited about the idea of taking "Let's Get Metaphysical" out into the greater community. It is an idea that I have had for a very long time.

After last month's Board Meeting's emphasis on outreach I was motivated to make the initial move of inquiring into what I had originally thought was a good place to begin this project-The Grace Heritage Center downtown. When I received a response that the Center was available for this, at a very inexpensive price, I was excited to begin to move forward with the planning.

Now that we are all on board with this project we are beginning to actually make specific plans and preparation for it.

I believe this will be a very good way for us to get our "open hearted, open minded," new" approach to spirituality out to the general public. Mostly because the emphasis is not to "sell our point of view", it is inform and educate those interested in a new way to see things.

Of course, I do have the hope that this new interest will result in more visits to our Sunday Morning Spiritual Experience.

Another point: if I had not mentioned it before, we have added a new and very musically powerful member [REDACTED] to our music ministry. [REDACTED] addition has been quite impactful.

Another out reach from last month's outreach initiative, I suggested we might be able to have community drum circles and mentioned that [REDACTED] had been part of a drum in the recent past. I reached out to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] sent me a flyer of monthly drum circles at the Unitarian Center downtown so I am suggesting we support that on-going project as a way to make a new connection with the Unitarian group as well as the greater community. Finally, this week I attended a Unity Workshop presented by UWM CEO Rev. Shad Groverland at Unity New Braunfels. The topic was a focus ministry. I shared some of the key ideas he presented, but I will be getting the entire power point presentation and Alice and I talked about sharing it with you at some point. I will that to Alice to share since it really is a Board thing.

Alice also asked me to share how attendance to LGM was going and we are consistently getting between 12 to 18 people on a regular basis. The enthusiasm remains very high about it and they are really excited about the LGM downtown project.

As you all probably saw, Cary forwarded some activities that the Chamber put out and I think that also would be a good way to get our word out to the greater community.
