



### **BUGS!** Patterning

As preschool and kindergarten aged children observe patterns all around them, parents and teachers point out these patterns and encourage a very fundamental math skill upon which other math skills will be built.

Print and use this BUGS! Patterning FREEBIE with your child as is or print the colored bugs on cardstock and laminate to extend the activity. Plastic insects can be used to create new patterns as well using bug type, size of bug, or color of bug. You might even have a budding entomologist on your hands.

Encourage your child to make his own bug patterns and tell them back to you. Remember each pattern needs to be repeated at least twice in order to be a pattern.

As your child words with patterns in everyday life, he will be ready to look for patterns in written text. Exciting stuff!


