Car Games for use on Road Trips

Cut out the four car game cards below and take them with you on your next field trip or outing to add some learning fun to your drive.

<p><i>Alphabet Practice Sign Game Rotation</i></p> <p><u>Directions:</u> Starting with the youngest person in the car and then one-at-a-time, each player must look out the window and find a word on a sign that starts with the next letter of the alphabet, starting with the letter A. The object is to go through the alphabet as many times as possible.</p>	<p><i>Alphabet Practice Sign Game Free Play</i></p> <p><u>Directions:</u> Starting with the youngest person in the car look out the window and find a word on a sign that starts with the next letter of the alphabet, starting with the letter A. Once a sign is found any player can blurt out a sign with the next letter. The object is to go through the alphabet as many times as possible.</p>
<p><i>Never Ending Sign Game Rotation</i></p> <p><u>Directions:</u> Starting with the youngest person in the car and then one-at-a-time, each player must look out the window and find a sign that starts with the last letter of the last person's sign word. The first player can choose any sign. Each player remembers the number of signs they got and the player that got the most number of signs wins. An example word be if a player found the sign Washington Avenue then the next player would have to find something that started with the letter 'e.'</p>	<p><i>Never Ending Sign Game Free Play</i></p> <p><u>Directions:</u> Starting with the youngest person in the car, look out the window and find any sign. 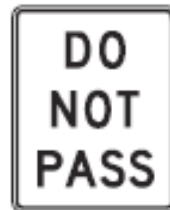

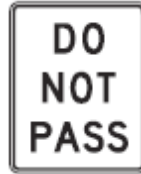
