

**GDPR Statement**

Metrikus Limited was formed in May 2019 and provides an Smart Building, Facilities Management service to its clients and via partners to enable real time monitoring of assets using a bespoke platform.

The range of data that Metrikus monitor within the platform is not considered to be personal or personal/sensitive under the definitions of the GDPR.

**How will Metrikus comply with the GDPR?**

As part of Metrikus' GDPR preparation the company has reviewed and updated (where necessary) all internal processes, procedures, data systems and documentation to ensure the company GDPR compliant.

**Metrikus GDPR Principles are:**

- Data is processed fairly and lawfully
