#### VICAR'S MESSAGE

Lent: Strong time for conversion

"Yet even now, says the Lord, return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping and with mourning; rend your hearts and not your clothing. Return to the Lord, your God" (Joel 2:12-13a)

#### Dear Loved ones in Christ,

February is a very important month in our church calendar, as from the 15<sup>th</sup> our church will observe 50 days of great Lent; it is an annual celebration of God's Salvation History. It is a season to develop greater spiritual discipline; it is time of repentance and renewals and orienting ourselves to the great Christian mystery of Easter.

The Cross is the 'epicenter' of eastern Christian spirituality. The Early church fathers always referred to the cross to explain events of their times. The church today also refers to the same Cross. Lent is an annual celebration of God's salvation history. It is not just a ritual, but a reliving experience. Participation in Christ's sufferings gives us the vision of God's greatness and share in His glory. Thus spiritual disciplines in the church revolve around the Cross.

Biblical basis: The annual fast and feasts were part of the rich religious heritage of the Jewish community. The Jerusalem temple was the center of it all. There were times of national crisis when the fast was proclaimed for soul searching and fresh commitment to the Lord of the Covenant, as a covenant community. The' forty days' are celebrated as memory of the forty days of fasting of Jesus in the wilderness of Judea (Matt.4:2; Mk 1:13; Lk.4:2). The number 40 also recalls several great moments in the journey of faith:the flood of Noah lasted 40 days. Moses stayed on Mount Sinai for 40 days, prophet Elijah walked for 40 days with food given by the angel (1 Kings 19:8), the Israelites wandered in the desert for 40 years. The Lenten season offers us once again an opportunity to reflect upon the very heart of Christian life:Charity. This is a favorable time to renew our journey of faith, both as individuals and as a community, with the help of the word of God and the sacraments. This journey is one marked by prayer and sharing, silence and fasting, in anticipation of the joy of Easter.

In a world which demands of Christians a renewed witness of love and fidelity to the Lord, may all of us feel the urgent need to anticipate one another in charity, service and good works (Heb. 6:10). This appeal is particularly pressing in this holy season of preparation for Easter. As I offer my prayerful good wishes for a blessed and fruitful Lenten Period.
