PROJECT GOAL

The case management team of this public health and social service nonprofit needed a skilled consultant to augment internal resources to design and execute the organizations request for proposal process.

ASSESSMENTS & PROJECT MANAGEMENT

Designing the RFP operation required designing processes, procedures and examining internal processes to draft policies and procedures supporting the case management operation.

The consulting team produced all RFP operational materials including RFP template, press releases, website content, evaluator recruitment tools, scoring / evaluation tools that were used in the implemented process.

The consultant oversaw the entire RFP process including selection of proposal reviewers, convening evaluation meetings, summarizing evaluation results; and drafting the final funding recommendations report to the AFC team.
