SUBJECT: Mandatory Policy Changes for 2026 – WST System Integration & PMA Compliance Deadline

### RE: Activation of the WST Global System & Governance Realignment for 2026

To all Trustees, Officers, and fiduciary personnel operating under the National Sales Corps (NSC) Global Master Trust and affiliate companies:

Effective **January 1, 2026**, the National Sales Corps will formally transition all operational, administrative, financial, and reporting functions into the **World Standing Together™ (WST)** governance and logistical ecosystem. This transition is mandated under master trust authority and applies to *all* subsidiary Series Trusts, Programs, Divisions, Officers, and Agents.

This letter serves as the **official notice of policy changes and required compliance actions**.

#### 1. Activation of the WST System (2026 Launch)

Beginning January 1, 2026, the following WST system components become mandatory across all NSC trusts:

# A. PMA (Private Membership Association) Operational Framework

All NSC trusts will now function under the unified **PMA jurisdictional architecture**, ensuring:

- privacy-protected trust operations
- removal from commercial/merchant-law exposure
- uniform governance standards across all countries
- harmonized operational procedures for WST global deployment

# **B.** Integration Into the WST Global Registry

Each NSC trust must be registered within the new WST Global Registry system, including:

- trust identification updates
- jurisdictional confirmation
- trustee verification
- operational classification
- alignment with 2026 policy requirements

# C. Unified Governance & Reporting Structure

All NSC trusts will adopt:

- standardized reporting protocols
- updated trustee obligations
- new risk management and compliance procedures
- WST-aligned operational templates and communication standards

### 2. Trustee & Officer Compliance Deadline — January 1, 2026

All current Trustees, Officers, and designated fiduciaries **must complete the new compliance process no later than**:

January 1, 2026 (Final Deadline)

Failure to comply will result in:

- temporary suspension of authority
- restriction of access to WST systems, databases, and resources
- potential reassignment of fiduciary duties
- review by the Executive Trustee's Office

### Compliance requirements include:

- 1. Updated Trustee Declaration (2026 version)
- 2. PMA Membership Acknowledgment
- 3. WST Governance & Reporting Agreement
- 4. Updated Verification Documents (per jurisdiction)
- 5. Acceptance of the 2026 NSC–WST Policy Framework

### 3. Policy Amendments for 2026

The following policies take effect on **January 1, 2026**:

### A. Centralization of Trust Oversight Under WST

All Series Trusts remain autonomous internally, but oversight, audit, and governance functions will now fall under the WST global structure.

#### **B. Standardization of Documents and Procedures**

All prior versions of forms, agreements, templates, and operational manuals are superseded. Only the 2026 PMA/WST editions are authorized.

### C. Revised Fiduciary Responsibilities

Trustees must:

- ensure compliance of all subordinate officers
- transition local documents into WST formats
- implement the unified risk management and reporting system
- maintain communication with regional WST coordinators

### D. Rule of Law & Jurisdictional Clarification

All NSC trusts are reaffirmed as:

- private
- non-statutory
- operating under land jurisdiction principles
- protected by PMA agreements and trust-law sovereignty

#### 4. Support & Transition Assistance

WST transition coordinators will be assigned to:

- · assist with registration
- provide compliance checklists
- help trustees integrate into the WST system
- support data migration

A separate communication will provide login credentials, training dates, and documentation links.

#### 5. Statement from the Executive Trustee

The 2026 transition marks the beginning of a unified global trust architecture capable of supporting:

- the full deployment of the WST humanitarian programs
- operational centers
- the global-charter rollout
- integrated financial, communications, and logistical systems
- sovereign protection for all trust participants
- all bank accounts, treaties, JVs, MOU and corporate entities must be realigned

This structural alignment is essential for safeguarding our mission, expanding our capacity, and ensuring legal and operational continuity for the next century.

#### 6. Required Action

All Trustees and Officers must complete the compliance process **on or before January 1, 2026** using the instructions provided in the transition package.

Failure to respond will be interpreted as non-compliance and addressed accordingly.
