Understanding the 10 Commandments

The Third Commandment - "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy" (Dt 20:2-17; Ex

On the surface, this command seems to be solely a religious obligation with no relevance to human dignity or human rights. But of course, this was not the case in ancient Israel, nor is it the case today. In addition to its religious requirements, it was a basic labor law. The rest of the Commandment reads: "Six days you shall labor, and do all your work; but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God: in it you shall not do any work". Deu-

teronomy 5:14 reads in part: "You shall not do any work. either you, your son or your daughter, your male or female slave, your ox or donkey or any work animal, or the resident alien within your gates, so that your male and female slave may rest as you do." Even slaves got the day off for rest in ancient times!

The Catechism reminds us of a truth too often forgotten by employers today: "In spite of economic constraints, public authorities should ensure citizens a time intended for rest and divine worship. Employers have a similar obligation toward their employees". Human dignity demands adequate periods of rest and respect for the rights of workers to rest. (USCCB, Colecchi) To be continued.
