Understanding the 10 Commandments

The Second Commandment - ""You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain" (Dt 20:2-17; Ex 5:6-21)

The name of the Lord is holy. The second commandment prescribes respect for the Lord's name. Like the first commandment, it belongs to the virtue of religion and more particularly governs our use of speech in secret matters.

Among all the words of revelation, there was one which is unique: the revealed name of God. God

confides His name to those who believe in Him. He reveals Himself to them in His personal mystery. The gift of a name belongs to the order of trust and intimacy. The Lord's name is holy. For this reason, a man must not abuse it. He must keep it in mind in silent love and adoration. He will not introduce it into his own speech except to bless, praise, and glorify it. (Catechism of the Catholic Church)

The Catechism also declares: "The second commandment forbids false oaths." God's honor obliges us to treat his name with reverence, and human dignity requires that persons be told the truth. (USCCB, Colecchi) To be continued.
