











City Shelter Asylum Seeker Housing Report: Updates

- ComEd began processing the 150 activation requests CCAC submitted between 2/14 2/20. Due to
 technical issues with their new system, their rate of activation was slower than usual. CCAC received 40
 activations last week but expects confirmation today that the remaining 80 accounts were activated, as
 ComEd planned to work over the weekend on the project.
- Support from IHDA on the number of pending applications per shelter and the expected amount of time
 it will take to process backlogs continues to be a need. The information will allow CCAC workers to
 recommend lease start dates with the expected delay times built in. Currently, IHDA will only accept
 applications if the lease start date is between 21 45 days in the future.
- Last week, CCAC's recent housing inventory list had 72 and 97 available units. Thank you for continuing to share the CCAC Landlord Interest form!



City Shelter Asylum Seeker Housing Report: Updates

- ComEd continues to work on the backlog of activation requests from 2/14 2/20 when their system was down. As of today, CCAC is waiting on 175 outstanding ComEd activation requests; 51 of which are from February.
- CCAC is working with DFSS to schedule Housing Location 101 info sessions which will be open to both ASERAP eligible and non-ASERAP eligible residents.
- Seven households at the Halsted shelter have signed leases that have not yet been submitted to IHDA.
 CCAC workers called the landlords to let them know there was a pause on rental application submission, but that they would be calling to get an updated lease start date as soon as we knew when IHDA would be able to accept the applications.
- The CCAC Housing Location team continues to outreach to LLs interested in the ASERAP program. Thank you for continuing to share the CCAC Landlord Interest form!







- A private donor gifted \$30k for basic needs for new arrivals. Catholic Charities is working with New Life
 to use the funding on sheets, blankets, and other household necessities.
- Beginning Jan 17, CCAC case managers will be onsite in all 24 shelters with ASERAP eligible residents. This
 week due to the holiday and weather they will be onsite Wednesday Friday. All residents eligible for
 ASERAP are now loaded into our client system.
- On Jan 11 CCAC flagged for ComEd 424 requests pending activation by ComEd. The pending request list
 is comprised of previously escalated requests (~90%) and new requests (~10%). ComEd is working
 towards their turn time goal of 48 hours but have shared they are behind due to the holidays. CCAC
 escalates a request, per ComEd instructions, after 4 business days if ComEd has not responded.
- Peoples Gas is hitting their turn target goal of 48 hours. However, as gas cannot be activated in units without electricity, CCAC is holding back on submitting Peoples Gas requests until receiving activation confirmation from ComEd.










