- Review & Approve Minutes from May 20th meeting: Approved.

III. Old Business:

- A. 11am Council representation We are still in search of a representative from the 11am Mass.
- B. Our Summer Children/Youth program: "Totus Tuus" has over 35 enrolled and we have many volunteer sign ups to assist with the program. Masses during Totus Tuus will be every day, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday at 11:30am, Confessions at 11am.
- C. 85th Parish Anniversary Status of Planning Committee LeAnn Wilson & Jennifer Puzerewski, CoChairs shared that the 85th Festival planning is in full swing. It was decided that the Vigil Mass on October 16th will be held at 4:00pm instead of 5:30pm. We will have our festival in Grovemont Park following the Mass. The plan is to have food, music, games for children, possibly a contra dancing caller that will appeal to all ages. IV. New Business:

A. Parish Hall Restoration – Council reviewed the plan to restore our Parish Hall to a "better than before" status. Catholic Mutual Insurance has paid \$33,900 to cover the flood mitigation, get the facility dried out and fixed back to how it was before the flood. Council agreed that we need to seal the walls, use insulation and use drywall instead of paneling and restore it to be better than before. Also a kitchen upgrade is needed and that will be planned. We hope to have the Hall in use sometime in October.

- V. <u>Miscellaneous</u>: Salvador Figueroa mentioned the Eucharistic Congress and suggested we think about chartering a bus for the day on Saturday, September 18th. Council discussed a pilgrimage to Charlotte for the Eucharistic Congress. We plan to have a sign up opportunity soon to measure interest in this pilgrimage. Council also discussed parishioners requests for periodic updates from our St. Vincent de Paul Society on how their funds have been helping the poor in our community. We used to have periodic blurbs that give a general idea of the areas of outreach. Beverly Penland will reach out to Mike Sobol to see if communications can be sent to church office for the bulletin at least quarterly.
