

White Rose Witness for the Right to Life in the Dobbs v. Jackson Case June 1, 2022

Background

On May 2, 2022, a draft of a US Supreme Court opinion in the Dobbs v. Jackson case was leaked to the public.

In response, USCCB pro-life chairman Archbishop Lori asked everyone "to intensify their prayer and fasting that the final decision of the Court will bring about the reversal of Roe and Casey."

The White Rose Witness Renewed

In response to this call for prayer and fasting, the Office of Family Life is asking all parishes in the diocese to renew the White Rose Witness on Wednesday, June 1, 2022 by wearing a White Rose all day and be ready to share why: "I am wearing this rose because I support the right to life from the moment of conception, and because I hope that the Supreme Court will overturn Roe v. Wade and allow our nation to protect unborn children."
