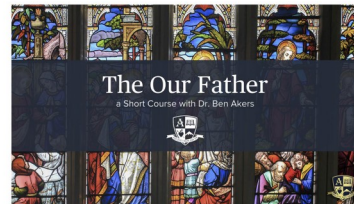

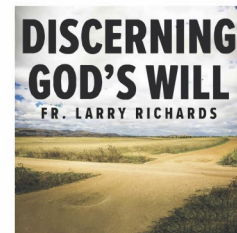


JESUS: THE MODEL AND MASTER OF PRAYER
