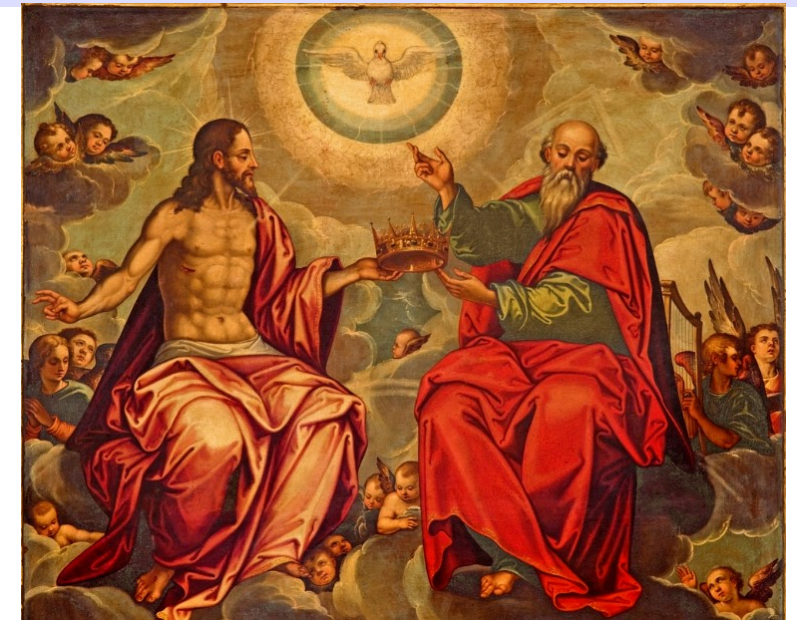
MARRIAGE:

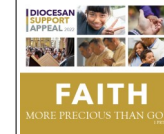
