



Do you know about Posadas?

What is a Posada? This is a question that a lot of people ask as we prepare to celebrate Christmas.

The tradition of the Posadas was brought to Mexico from Spain in the 1500's by Catholic Missionaries. The Posadas commemorate Mary and Joseph's difficult journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem in search of a place for the Christ Child to be born. In Spanish, the word means dwelling or lodging. The Posadas are not to be confused with a mere Christmas party. Instead, the Posadas should be seen as a religious event.

In Catholic parishes, parishioners and anyone who wishes to join in meet at the church a specific time during the early evening. The Posada can be led by a small group carrying a manger scene or the Posada can become elaborate with a live donkey and parishioners who are dressed like Mary and Joseph.

La Posada dinner includes such Hispanic dishes as tamales and posoli. Each Posada ends with the traditional piñata. The seven corners of each piñata represents the Seven Deadly Sins. The beating of the piñata symbolizes the mortification that Christians exercise in overcoming personal sin. The candy within each piñata characterizes the sweetness of God's grace made available to us through the birth of Jesus.



¿Qué es una Posada? Esta es una pregunta que muchos se hacen al prepararnos para celebrar la Navidad.

La tradición de las Posadas llegó a México desde España en el siglo XVI gracias a los misioneros católicos. Las Posadas conmemoran el difícil viaje de María y José desde Nazaret hasta Belén en busca de un lugar donde naciera el Niño Jesús. En español, la palabra significa morada o alojamiento. Las Posadas no deben confundirse con una simple fiesta navideña. Más bien, deben considerarse un evento religioso.

En las parroquias católicas, los feligreses y cualquier persona que desee participar se reúnen en la iglesia a una hora específica al anochecer. La Posada puede ser dirigida por un pequeño grupo que lleva un pesebre o puede ser más elaborada, con un burro vivo y feligreses vestidos como María y José.

La cena de la Posada incluye platillos hispanos como tamales y posoli. Cada Posada termina con la tradicional piñata. Las siete esquinas de cada piñata representan los Siete Pecados Capitales. El golpeteo de la piñata simboliza la mortificación que los cristianos ejercen para superar el pecado personal. El dulce dentro de cada piñata representa la dulzura de la gracia de Dios que se nos ofrece a través del nacimiento de Jesús.
