A great fun day on the bike, The Milawa region is fast becoming renowned for being the gourmet hub of regional Victoria, and for good reason. The combination of fertile land, Italian heritage, fine weather and an Alpine backdrop are ideal for wine and food. Exploring this area on bike is the perfect way to discover the gourmet delights on offer, whilst enjoying the outdoor delights of the area.

The **Tour de Pedal to Produce is a self-guided cycling day tour**. Enjoy cycling at your own pace, stop for as long as you want at the designated stops, and explore places off the beaten path if your heart desires. You are provided with directions, bookings and on call support should you need it, return transport and purchase pick ups are included so you don't have to carry anything. It's an easy day's cycling, fun and let's you enjoy food, wine & scenery without stress.

Beechworth

The starting point is the delightful historic town of **Beechworth**, in North East Victoria.

How To Get There

Drive

Beechworth is approx. a 285km, 3 hour drive north of Melbourne. Follow the Hume Freeway (M31) north until you see the Beechworth sign.

Train

There is a VLine service to Wangaratta from Melbourne www.vline.com.au . Ask about our transfers from Wangaratta.

Flights

A number of airlines fly to Albury from Melbourne, Sydney & Brisbane. Ask us about transfer services from the airport.

What To Bring

We provide you with detailed cycling directions once your booking is confirmed, which you need to print and have with you. We also suggest you take your mobile phone, and a few other items including:

- Water bottle, sunscreen, sunglasses, hat
- Bike helmet (can be provided with bike hire)
- Cycling clothing (loose/comfortable/shorts)
- Puncture repair/spare tube/pump (if you are using your own bikes).
- Camera and wallet to purchase those wines!

The Tour

Bikes

You can BYO bike or choose to use one of our hire bikes. We use Trek FX 24 gear hybrid bikes or perhaps try an electric assist bike! (see below).

Start

Your tour includes a **free espresso coffee at the Old Beechworth Gaol** café (our bikes are here as well if you're hiring). We recommend heading off around 9.30am. This will allow enough time to enjoy the stops, make your lunch booking on time and visit the gourmet outlets in Milawa. If you haven't already it's worth having a quick look around Beechworth before joining the rail trail to Milawa.

Cycling the Murray to Mountains Rail Trail Your cycling tour covers approx **35kms of downhill and flat** (see elevation graph below) cycling from Beechworth to Milawa. You will enjoy the off road Murray to Mountains Rail Trail and quiet back country roads. **Detailed cycling directions and instructions are provided.**

Enjoy the downhill roll from Beechworth to Everton!

There are no up-hills on this tour!

Food & Wine

Your tour includes a variety of recommended cellar door and produce stops as well as lunch. Lunch is a delicious platter and drinks (except alcohol) at the famous Milawa Cheese Factory, its' popularity is no surprise.

You can purchase as much as you like without having to worry about carrying your new delights with our collection service included in your tour.

On Call Support

It's good to know that help isn't far away, although we hope you don't need it! Bike issues or other problems are a simple call to our **1300** number and assistance will be provided, including pick up if needed.

Pick Up & Return Transport

We will collect you and any purchases you have made and transfer you back to Beechworth, along with the bikes. Your collection point is at Brown Brothers so it's the perfect place to end the tour. Park your bikes right next to the cellar door. **Be ready for a 4.30pm collection** back to Beechworth where the tour concludes.
