

We, the mothers, wives, widows, grandmothers, sisters, daughters, stepdaughters and granddaughters of the American Veteran and female veterans, fully realizing our responsibilities to the community, State and nation, associate ourselves for the following purposes: To uphold and defend the Constitution of the United States of America; to safeguard the principles of freedom, liberty and justice for all; to promote the cause of peace and good will among nations; to maintain inviolate the freedom of our country; to preserve the fundamentals of democracy and Americanism; to perpetuate the friendship and associations of the American Veteran and to dedicate ourselves to the cause of mutual assistance...this by the grace of God.

CODE OF ETHICS

Because I am fortunate in being able to qualify for membership in AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary; and because I am proud of our affiliation with the parent organization, AMVETS, I must always remember that it is my duty as a member —

- 7. To show my interest in our organization by attending all meetings and be on time.
- 8. To accept the rule of the majority gracefully.
- 9. To assume leadership in right thinking and action.
- 10. To respect my officers, my fellow members and the opinions they may have.
- 11. To be temperate in my speech, habits and opinions.
- 12. To be extremely careful if I am honored by being elected to any office on any level, that the weight of my office is never used to unduly influence the affairs of our organization or of our parent organization, AMVETS.
- 13. To endeavor to follow all the purposes of AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary, as set forth in our Constitution, because by doing so, I am serving all mankind, regardless of race, creed or color.
- 14. Finally, believing that the Golden Rule, "All things whatsoever you would that men should do unto you, do ye even so unto them," applies to all of us, do my part to see that equal opportunity is given to each member to contribute to the good of the AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary.

- 6. To cooperate with duly recognized existing veteran's organizations in the furtherance of the aims of the American Veteran.
- 7. To keep the public forever reminded that the American fought, served, and died to preserve peace, liberty and democracy for their nation.
- 8. To aid in the fulfillment of the Aims and Purposes of AMVETS, our parent organization.
- 9. To promote the welfare and fellowship of our members and families.
- 10. To expedite and assist in the rehabilitation of the veteran by sponsoring and giving support to educational opportunities, to recreational advantages, to hospitalization and personal problems, and to support the veterans in all legislation for veteran's benefits.
- 11. To recognize that the organization known as AMVETS, and chartered by Congressional action on July 23, 1947, is the parent organization, and that all organizational divisions of the Auxiliary exist to promote the interest of the parent body, therefore, they cannot act independently except as it favors the objectives of AMVETS.

General Rules

- 1. Except as herein expressly modifies by these rules, Roberts Rules of Order, Revised, shall govern proceedings of this Conference not otherwise provided for.
- 2. To expedite business, the printed agenda shall be followed as closely as possible.
- 3. No one shall be admitted to the Conference floor without evidence of being registered as either a Delegate, Alternative, Guest, State or National Officer.
- 4. No seating restriction shall be invoked during the general sessions.
- 5. Fully accredited Delegate, Alternate or any member in good standing will be entitled to a voice in the meeting. Only accredited Delegates or their Alternates can vote on any subject matter before the Conference body.
- 6. Any person who desires recognition for the purpose of making a motion or addressing the body, must rise, proceed to the floor microphone, address the chair as madam President, state her name and her Auxiliary and shall speak after she is recognized by the chair.
- 7. Debate shall be limited to two (2) minutes for the speaker. The floor shall be permitted but twice to any individual Delegate on any one subject, except however, a Delegate who proposed the matter may be accorded a two (2) minute rebuttal.
- 8. Vote on a motion shall be at the discretion of the presiding officer. Many routine motions can be voted on orally. When a motion requires a two-thirds vote, or on contested votes, the presiding officer may call a rising or hand vote and it shall be her privilege to use the closed ballot or roll call vote, if necessary.
- 9. Discussion of personal grievances, local conditions, or claims concerning an individual with respect to her personal interest, shall not be permitted before the conference.



If they are not sent in, you will not be in compliance, thus you will not be able to vote at Convention/Conference, nor will you receive membership pre-prints, new membership cards nor a roster until they are sent into Department.
- 4). The only members that are voted on are: yearly review of present Honorary members or selecting one for this year, and transfers. If someone applies and meets the qualifications to be a member of Auxiliary, you DO NOT vote to allow them to join.

Madam President, Officers, Members and Guests:


Our VAVS Representatives have not been able to go into VA facilities since March, 2020. This has been very difficult for everyone, especially the Veterans. However, each Representative has taken items needed by the Veterans in their VA Hospitals and dropped them off to Voluntary Services. If you would like to donate items, please contact your local VAVS Representative and work out a time to meet at the VA for distribution.

Each of our VAVS Representatives have completed their Annual Joint Review (AJR) which is required by National and the Department of Veterans Affairs. These AJRs must be completed each year with the Chief of Voluntary Services. They show AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary total hours, number of volunteers, and total donations to each individual VA Hospital in Ohio.

The needs of our Veterans are what AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary is all about. We need to always strive to ensure that they are well cared for, their needs are met, and that they feel important and needed.

Here are some items that can be donated at your VA Hospital or nursing home. Items which are accepted include —

- > 3 in 1 Shampoo, Conditioner and Body Wash
- > Deodorant
- Combs and hair brushes
- > Toothpaste and toothbrushes
- > T-shirts and underwear for men
- > White socks and diabetic socks for men and women
- > Sweatshirts and sweatshirts for men (sizes L, XL, 1X and 2X)
- > Sweatshirt and sweatpants for females
- > Bras and underwear for females (sizes L, XL, !X and 2X)
- Individually packaged items such as:
 - o Chips
 - o Cookies
 - Crackers
 - Candy (regular and sugar free)
- > Telephone Cards
- Bus tickets
- Sewing Kits





- > DVDs & DVD Players
- > Body Lotions, Lip Balm, nail files, large nail clippers
- > Individual tissue (Kleenex, etc.), Individual hand sanitizers
- > Word Search, Crossword Puzzles, small pads of paper and pens

When donating either cash or comfort items at any VA Hospital in Ohio there is a form called a Donation Slip. Your completed slips must be turned in to the Voluntary Services Office. You can obtain these Donation Slips from your Voluntary Service Office.

VA Hospital programs include the following:

- > AMVETS Because We Care Day is held the first Wednesday of April each year or as close to that date as possible. AMVETS and Auxiliaries distribute care packages or hold other activities for our veterans at all VA Medical Centers that have certified AMVETS and Auxiliary Representatives. (Check with your Local VAVS Representative as to the time they will be distributing packages or other activities for Because We Care Day).
- > Salute to Veterans. This Salute is a program sponsored by the VA and is held the week in February that contains Valentine's Day. To participate in this program contact the Department Hospital Chairman or your local Department VAVS Representative.
- > At Home Program. For those who cannot go to a VA Hospital but can make items at home for use by Veterans in a hospital or nursing home.
- > James H. Parke Scholarship. This is a scholarship for youth volunteers.
- > St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Please remember that the National Program for Hospital is St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Please consider having a function to raise funds for St. Jude. They have saved the lives of so many children who have catastrophic diseases. St. Jude Children's Research Hospital is the first institution

established for the sole purpose of conducting basic and clinical research into catastrophic childhood diseases, mainly cancer. Families never receive a bill from St. Jude. St. Jude pays for treatment, travel, housing and food because all a family should worry about is helping their child live. Everything St. Jude does is centered around finding cures and saving children. Their daily operating costs is \$2.2 Million, which is primarily covered by individual donations. If you plan to have a fundraiser for St. Jude let me know and if possible I would love to attend.

If you have any questions, concerns, or ideas please do not hesitate to talk to me this weekend, and if not, you can either call or e-mail me. I have an open door policy. I believe that communication is the key to success and I want Ohio to have a very successful year with our Hospital Program.



Madam President Kay, may you have a successful Mid-Winter Conference. Everyone have a safe trip home and stay healthy and take care of yourselves.



We have not had any VAVS meetings and don't know when we will. We just keep plugging along and hope that one day we can get back to "normal".



VA Northeast Ohio Healthcare System Mid-Winter Report 2021

Madam President, Officers, Members and Guests:

The VA Northeast Ohio Healthcare System has 17 locations of care. There are Out-Patient Clinics in Akron, Canton, East Liverpool, Lorain, Mansfield, New Philadelphia, Parma, Ravenna, Sandusky, Warren, Willoughby and Youngstown. We have 2 community resource and referral centers, a psychosocial resource rehabilitation center, a chronic dialysis center and an ambulatory surgery center which serve the Veterans in Northeast Ohio. Cleveland is the third largest VA Hospital in the nation and rated as one of the best.

At this time I am still unable to volunteer at the VA. I take items when requested and they are picked up at the front door by staff from Voluntary Services and then distributed to the patients.

At June Convention I introduced those in attendance to my former Deputy Representative Janet Juncker. Due to health issues Janet was forced to resign her position after having volunteered at the VA for more than 15 years. I received a call on December 16 from Janet's husband advising me that she passed away that morning from COVID-19. Janet was more than just my Deputy Rep, she was my friend and I miss her so much. Please keep her husband Jim and their sons in your thoughts and prayers. Janet fought and beat cancer twice, and yet COVID-19 take her life. She was a very strong and caring lady.

We have had a larger than usual number of homeless Veterans admitted to the VA due to COVID-19. Most of them were admitted with nothing but the clothing they were wearing. I purchased socks, jeans and sweatshirts for these Veterans.

In October, 2020 I purchased 284 chap sticks and 160 disposable razors for our VA because they were completely out. These items are always in demand.

The week of Christmas I purchased and delivered 4 large trays of cookies to the Veterans on different Units of the Hospital. Thank goodness I got them there on the 22nd because the next morning it was mandated that no party trays could be brought into the Hospital.

In January, 2021 I was advised that the Hospital was in desperate need of men's underwear. I ordered 12 packs of men's underwear which had 6 pairs in each package.

The Hospice Unit also advised me that they were in need of more zippered sweatshirts and sweatpants. They use a lot of these because when we lose a patient everything is given to their families. Nothing that is given to the patients from either the VA or outside sources can be reused.

I also purchased 4 boxes of assorted chips and 4 boxes of assorted crackers for Hospice and the Oncology Department. When the Veterans complete their chemo treatments they are given a snack.

Cleveland VA Voluntary Services decided not to hold their Christmas Gift Shop this year because of COVID-19; instead we will have a Christmas in July. \$300.00 of my balance will be designated for Christmas in July.

VA Northeast Ohio Healthcare System was one of the first VA Hospitals in the country to receive the COVID vaccine. All of the patients and most of the staff have been given their short and most have received or are now receiving the second inoculation. They are also inoculating all out-patient Veterans who are registered as patients with the VA. We were advised that when all staff and Veterans have been given their shots they will begin to inoculate the volunteers who have not already received the vaccine. However, even with the vaccine it will still be quite some time before volunteers are allowed in VA facilities. They are stressing to all veterans, staff and volunteers that even if you have received the vaccine you still must follow the guidelines of wearing masks and social distancing.

I am thankful to Department and all of you for allowing me to continue to serve our Veterans in Northeast Ohio. I love what I do at the VA and hopefully will be able to return soon.



My Deputies, volunteers, and I have been waiting eagerly for the Dayton VA to let us start back up with our luncheons and bingo which are held on the last Saturday of every month in Building 305 in the Multipurpose Room.

I called the Voluntary Services at the Dayton VA to find out when we could complete my Annual Joint Review (AJR) that was due in September. I finally completed my AJR on December 10, 2020. I reminded them about the delivery of August 21, 2020 which contained 11 boxes of snacks packs, 48 bottles of 3-1 body wash, and a Walmart gift card of \$50.00 from Ladies Auxiliary Department of Ohio VAVS.

On Thursday, December 10, 2020, we did our quarterly VAVS meeting via teleconference. They still do not know what the plans are for us to begin our visits in 2021. The last update looks like it might be March or later.

On December 11, 2020 I went to Rural King and bought 23 knit toboggan hats, 24 pairs of jeans, and 2 boxes of microwave popcorn which had 30 packages in each box. Total of \$355.65. Then I went to Walmart and bought 24 pairs of tennis shoes, and 20 zip-up sweat jackets with hoodies with flannel lining. Total of \$438.72.

I went to VA and met Julie, Voluntary Service Assistant at the dock for Building 305 on December 18, 2020 I purchased and delivered the above items from Rural King and Walmart, plus what the Juniors had given for the Veterans at Dayton VA (48 tree ornaments, the lap blankets they made last year and this year, and one I made for a total of 15.

For Valentine's Day on January 17, 2021, I ordered from Dollar Tree 48 cans of mixed nuts, 48 bottles of 3 in 1 body wash, 48 bags of Lifesavers mints, 36 back packs with zippers to load up these goodies to take to patient's rooms. Total Cost \$213.37. I also went to Sam's Club on January 23,2021 and bought 10 boxes of various snacks, cookies, chips, Fritos, 6 flats of Vienna sausage cans, and 2 boxes MW popcorn. Total Cost \$185.00.

I also am having some of our youth coloring pages of Thank You's for our Veterans which I will take to the VA for Valentine's Day. Thank You from Kiddie Launch Learning Center in Fairborn, Ohio and Stacy Leggett President of Auxiliary Post 444 Fairborn, Ohio that helped facilitate this.






I again, thank you for allowing me to serve in this position.

It has been since March that we have been allowed to go into the Ohio Veterans Home due to the coronavirus and many of the residents and workers contacting it. We have been able to drop off items and have workers meet to deliver them. It is definitely not the same as being there to see their faces brighten while playing bingo, enjoying a conversation or eating a cookie you had just made and brought to share. The joy when they call bingo and win those few dollars.

Department AMVETS Family (AMVETS and Auxiliary) purchased 200 hoodies thanks to the stipend we get at conferences and convention along with a goody bag for each one. The goody bags had chips, doritos, cheetos, crackers, donuts, cookies, beef sticks granola bars, rice crispy treats and more in each one. We delivered on the 23rd of December. Thank you Post 95 AMVETS Family for the \$1400.00 donation, Auxiliary 51 for the \$500.00 donation, and Auxiliary 1994 for the \$250.00 donation towards Project "Hoodies". There are other ways we can help at the home by providing essentials such as Fixodent or polident tablets, alcohol free mouthwash, wheelchair cup holders, wheelchair gloves, shaving cream, deodorant, etc. Ohio Veterans Home is also looking for I-Pads so residents can communicate with their loved ones, the workers can use them and go room to room. They have to be covered and disinfected after use. We purchased 18 JBL portable Bluetooth speakers so they can hear better when visiting on the I-pads. All supplies are drop off at this point.

The Ohio Veterans Home was one of the first to receive the vaccine for Covid 19 the Saturday before Christmas, even the governor showed up. Kim Llewellen said 80% of the residents were given the vaccine along with all the staff. Keep the residents and workers in your prayers as Covid 19 struck there with a vengeance. The residents have been in lockdown for 10 months already. They still do hallway bingo and Friday they provide donuts but with a different twist which brings joy to their lives. Because we care is coming in April and we will provide personal care packages that we make up ourselves.

Ladies if you would like to donate to the Ohio Veterans Home we will your donations to good use. Please send them to me at the address below and we will make sure you are informed as to how your donation is spent. The Ohio Veterans home has a greenhouse that they would like to refurbish due to needing repair. This is a space the residents go to tend to plants as a place of relaxation and solitude. If you would like to donate towards this renovation please send the money to me but in the memo put greenhouse project.



District Officers shall be elected and installed in the month of May and assume their duties prior to June 1st 2021. To be installed by the National President, a National Officers,

Department President, a Department Officer or a Past Department President only.

Local Auxiliaries shall have 1st nominations in April, and 2nd nominations and elections in May and be legally installed prior to June 1st. They may be installed by the National President, a National Officer, Department President, a Past Department President or a past local President.

All revalidation forms must be completed on both sides, and to include a copy that your 990 form with the IRS has been accepted.

These forms must be to the Department Headquarter prior to June Convention in order to be in good standing to run for a Department Officer or be seated at the Convention.



At this time, we still have Auxiliaries that are not in good standing with the Department or National. These Auxiliaries are now in jeopardy of losing their charter.

I'd like to thank those Auxiliaries that at the start of the year stepped up and send in their revalidation forms 990 along with proof of filing to stay in good standing.

Just a reminder our Uniform By-Laws can only be changed at our June Convention, so if you have any proposed recommendations/amendments they must be submitted sixty (60 days) prior to the Convention to me.

Standing Rules may be changed at any meeting.

We must all remember the reason we are here, not to have a place to party, but to help our veterans and our communities. That is what we were chartered to do.




Hoping our Convention is safe for everyone attending and the weather holds out for a safe journey.
