Kaufman Harvest Fest FAQ's

- May I purchase tickets on-site? Yes, tickets will be available through Eventbrite or by going to Kaufmanevents.com. Attendees are encouraged to purchase tickets in advance using the Eventbrite app or online. Day of ticket prices will increase to \$30 general admission and \$90 VIP access (Presale tickets through Oct. 21 are \$25 general admission and \$85 VIP access).
- Can I pay for admission tickets with cash? No. Ticket sales are through Eventbrite, payable by credit card only; no cash will be accepted at the gate. There will not be an ATM on site.
- **Is seating provided?** No seating is provided in General Admission, but lawn chairs and blankets are welcome!
- What items are prohibited? Tents, umbrellas, firearms, weapons of any kind, no outside food or beverages, no professional cameras or recording equipment, drones, skateboards, glass
- Can I bring in coolers with food and drinks? No, Food trucks will be available for the on-site purchase of food and drinks.
- Do children need tickets? Children under the age of 5 years have free admission.
- Do I need to pay for parking? Parking is free.
- What happens if there is inclement weather on the day of the event? This is a rain-or-shine event. There will be no refunds.
- Are pets allowed? No
- What times are the artists playing? Gates open at 2:00 PM. Music begins with Christopher Wright at approximately 2:15 PM, followed by Holly Tucker, Zac Wilkerson, Blue Water Highway, Joshua Ray Walker, and Cory Morrow. The show concludes at approximately 11:00 PM.
- **Is there a Bag policy?** No backpacks, totes, etc. Purses no larger than 12" x 6" x 12" are permitted.
- Is smoking allowed? No
- **Is there a lost and found?** Any found items of value will be given to the City of Kaufman for pick up the following week
- **Public safety?** Security Officers will be on site.
