## Managing Trade Waste

Liquid trade waste is a waste stream produced by a company in any industry that differs in characteristics to that of typical sewage from domestic applications. Due to the variability in the quality of liquid trade wastes, councils, and water authorities impose discharge requirements that must be met for it to be admitted to the sewer network. These can be as simple as pH correction through to advanced treatment for the removal of dissolved solids
