MCM Christian Ministry Scholarship Requirements

- Students applying for the Micah Cornerstone Ministries (MCM) Christian Ministry Scholarship (MCM CMS) must be born-again Christians who are answering God's call into full-time Christian vocation.
- 2. Scholarship applicants are required to have been accepted by the Office of Admissions at an accredited College or University in a traditional undergraduate degree program. Students pursuing an Online or Graduate level program are not eligible for this scholarship.
- 3. Applicants must submit a detailed letter of recommendation from their pastor which annotates the applicant's longevity and involvement with worship, ministry, and the applicants communicated future ministry goals, and two academic references.
- 4. Applicants must be able to demonstrate a cumulative 3.0 or higher GPA (at time of application).
- 5. Recipients are expected to live, and maintain, a godly and moral life.
- 6. Scholarship recipients, out of appreciation for the financial assistance received from MCM, are expected to share the ministry of MCM, encouraging others to become mission partners of the organization.
- 7. Recipient must maintain full-time student enrollment status.
- 8. Any recipient that drops out of the College or University in which they received the scholarship for attending or does not maintain full-time student enrollment status as outlined in the MCM CMS application, will be expected to return the scholarship funds in full to MCM within one (1) calendar year from date of withdrawal/removal, for redistribution to another applicant/recipient. Notification of withdrawal is required and is to be submitted in writing to the Board of MCM within thirty (30) days of withdrawal date, whether because of academic standing, attendance, no longer feeling "called", or for any other reason. - 9. Recipients are expected to keep MCM aware of their current contact information (mailing address, email address, and telephone number) during their time at the University and afterward for a period of three (3) years after completion of the approved degree.
- 10. Recipients will agree without reservation to allow MCM unrestricted use, at a minimum, of the student's name, hometown and state, educational goals, and other associated information for use in all means of advertising without any compensation or prior approval or knowledge.
