



WHAT THE LORD SAID ABOUT THE ESCAPE RAPTURE AND FIRE

I was praying and studying the Scriptures when I heard the Lord say "I am displeased... He talked about why and what it was all about and said: "Many will be hurt in coming days because of the false teaching of a rapture. "
I also heard him talking about the COMING FIRE OF JUDGMENT, THE DAY OF TRIBULATION. He talked about how the Fire would burn up all the bad works, and only the good would remain.

HERE IS WHAT HE WENT ON TO SAY:

I AM sore displeased that there are so many voices talking now in the American Church about the order of events that are completely wrong as to what the Scriptures say about the coming of the Tribulation days.
I AM CONCERNED THAT MANY WILL BE HURT BY WHAT THEY BELIEVE [have been taught to believe] ABOUT THE "RAPTURE" TEACHING THAT THE CHURCH WILL ESCAPE ALL AND GO IMMEDIATELY TO THE MARRIAGE.

It is all out of order and the reason it is out of order is because of the false teaching which has laid a wrong foundation.

Foundations are laid that are built upon sand, with no strength to hold them together. Like a home with little or no foundation!

I AM THE STRONG FOUNDATION; THE ONLY TRUE FOUNDATION UPON WHICH TO BUILD, BUT MANY BUILD [TO BEGIN WITH] IMPROPER FOOTINGS.

They will Fall Down Hard to much destruction, and they will forever know and remember the reasons. But it will be too late after they do look up and see where they fell from. Too Late to put them right again, for they have fallen.

I speak now NOT OF ETERNAL SALVATION, which is only in me the Savior. They fall NOT out of Me, but they fall in Future. There can be NO FRUIT upon the tree without good soil.

Fruit is what I see missing and few understand, I give Fruit through work and proper sowing.

I will not be able to reward them, for their fruit is not lasting; it will burn up in the coming fire of judgment.

Wood, Hay, and Stubble, perishing things will burn up with great heat. YET BECAUSE I BOUGHT THEM WITH MY OWN BLOOD AND THEY ARE MINE, YET WILL THEY REMAIN MINE. THE ONLY THING THEY WILL CONTINUE TO NOT HAVE, IS "REWARDS FOR SERVICE DONE IMPROPER!"

Yes! Men are SAVED BY GRACE, my favor in Love, for I did for them what they could not do: I satisfied the curse against them, and I accepted them as Righteous when they were not Righteous. I gave them My Righteousness and did Justify them by My Blood Shed for them on my Cross.

SAVED YES! They are Mine, but they have been Hurt by False Teachers who told them wrong things. They have failed to invest themselves to good works but have gone astray from my perfect plan for them and I will not be able to say to them: "You have done well with what I gave you, now enter into Joy. I WILL JUDGE MY PEOPLE [ALL OF THEM] IN THE END TIME TRIBULATION AND BY FIRE REVEAL TO ALL TO SEE THEIR WORKS DONE [QUALITY OF THEIR WORK BOTH OLD AND NEW] AND IN THAT DAY I HAVE SAID MANY WHO WERE FIRST SHALL BE LAST AND MANY WILL NOT BE GIVEN REWARDS, BUT FIND THEIR REWARDS GIVEN TO ANOTHER.

IN THAT DAY MANY WILL BE CALLED TO JUDGMENT, BUT FEW CHOSEN.

Those Chosen will escape and will be filled with great Joy, but many will weep having no reward.

They will not be taken to my Special Hiding Place but will be burned in Fire and that Fire will reveal their true nature [they will yet be Mine!]"

Scriptures:

2 Peter 2:1 - But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

1 CORINTHIANS 3:

9 For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.

10 According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon.

11 For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.

ISAIAH 66:

15 For, behold, the LORD will come with fire, and with his chariots like a whirlwind, to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire.

16 For by fire and by his sword will the LORD plead with all flesh: and the slain of the LORD shall be many.

HEBREWS 12:

And this word, Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which cannot be shaken may remain.

28 Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:

29 For our God is a consuming fire.

MATTHEW 25:

the Son of man cometh.

14 For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods.

15 And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

16 Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents.

17 And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two.

18 But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.

19 After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.

20 And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more.

21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

22 He also that had received two talents came and said, Lord, thou deliveredst unto me two talents: behold, I have gained two other talents beside them.

23 His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

24 Then he which had received the one talent came and said, Lord, I knew thee that thou art an hard man, reaping where thou hast not sown, and gathering where thou hast not strawed:

25 And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.

26 His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:

27 Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury.

28 Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents.

29 For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.

30 And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
