

Tampa Bay Bondage Club Meeting Minutes/January 9, 2026

The January 9, 2026 meeting of the Tampa Bay Bondage Club was at the Tampa home of Ross S. and Richard S. 13 members attended and there were five guests and/or pledges. Prior to the start of the meeting, members participated in two non-member demos. Rick M. demonstrated superior rigging talent on his rope bunny Alex. Alex was stripped and roped extensively. Lee P. was straightjacketed, blindfolded and ball-gagged by Richard S. and presented to the group for play. Lee's cock was also caged and locked. With his chastity key inside a lock box and inaccessible, Lee made a fine sub, spending considerable time in his bondage predicament.

Members were reminded to bring cash or their checkbooks for annual dues at the next meeting. Craig C. mentioned if any members desired name badges they could be purchased through the club.

March TBBC officer elections were discussed. Joe W. agreed to serve another year as president. Jeff J. will continue as secretary for another year as will Craig C. as treasurer. Vice President Bill M. is termed out so the March election will be for VP only.

The February 6th meeting was set for Jeff J.'s in Gulfport.

The Camp Mars July 4th weekend was discussed to determine the number of campers attending.

Jim P. said he would be in contact with the management of Purple Rhino in Sarasota for another TBBC Club Night, perhaps on a Thursday or Friday night in cooperation with the Hounds of Southwest Florida.
