ANNI'S GIFT

Anni's Gift, through Anni's Army Foundation, helps pediatric brain cancer patients and more. 2023 Anni's Gifts include:

- A 9-year-old pediatric brain cancer patient and his family were gifted grocery gift cards as he entered hospice care at home.
- A propane bill was paid and then some for a 7-year-old brain cancer patient and her family.
- A large auto insurance bill was paid off for the family of a 12year-old pediatric brain cancer patient with multiple recurrences over the last few years. The financial assistance allowed mom to take unpaid time off to take her daughter to post-surgical therapy and radiation appointments.
- Anni's Army Foundation was honored to meet and support Hazel, a beautiful and strong 8-year-old girl with Down Syndrome and Autism. She was in need of a wheelchairaccessible van. With the help of Anni's Gift, Hazel's family was able to purchase a van for her.
- The family of a 9-year-old brain tumor patient in hospice care was sent a variety of gift cards to aid with gas, groceries, and food to their favorite restaurants. This young man was diagnosed with the same type of brain tumor as Anni.
- Anni's Gift covered a sizeable utility bill for the family of a 5year-old brain tumor patient.
- A donation was made to the family of a young girl with DIPG who wished to go skiing as her final trip. Her dream came true and was rockstar on the slopes!

Anni's Army Foundation directed **99%** of its donations to current programs. Those programs include:
