RESEARCH FUNDED

Anni's Army Foundation continues to support Dr. Michael Taylor and his team of dedicated researchers at Texas Children's Hospital in the research of preventative therapies, non- invasive treatment options, and providing quality of life for children with particularly difficult to treat pediatric brain tumors, including medulloblastoma. Anni's Army Foundation has donated \$85,000 over last three years to this research.

DONATIONS
