

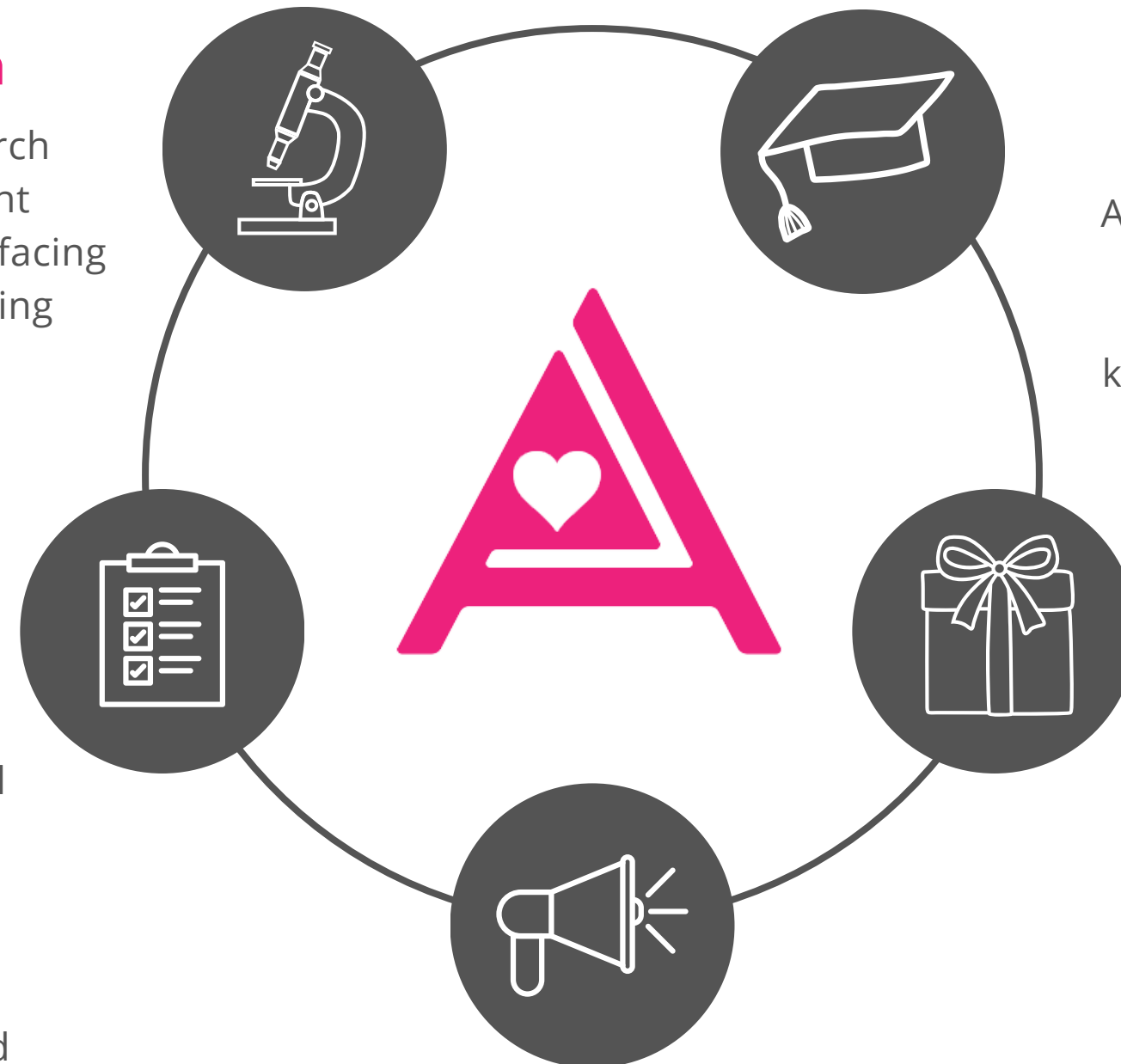
# WHAT WE DO

## Fund Innovative Research

We invest in innovative pediatric cancer research focused on prevention, less invasive treatment options, and improved quality of life for children facing the most difficult-to-treat brain tumors, including medulloblastoma.

## Support Hospital-Based Programs
