Elevating Homes Program (EHP)



What is the Elevating Homes Program (EHP)?

EHP is a program that is being implemented by the Communities of Everglades Disaster Recovery, Inc. (CEDR) a 501 (C)(3) non-profit with funding from the Community Foundation of Collier County and the State of Florida.

The Elevating Homes Program is intended to fund the elevation of homes in Everglades City, Chokoloskee and Plantation Island for low to moderate income homeowners that were affected by Hurricane Ian.

Who is eligible to apply?

All single family homeowners within the service area that experienced damage due to Hurricane Ian are encouraged to submit a pre-application. Submission of a pre-application does not guarantee service through EHP.

The pre-application period is open from March 15th through April 15th.
