For this program, LBPC features our own Music Director Donna Beech, editor of two books of Ann Wyeth McCoy's piano music. Donna completed the first book in 2017 after working in tandem with Ann's daughter Robin McCoy. "Book Two, Of Paintings and a Sculpture" was completed in 2020 and includes input from Ann's daughter Anna B. McCoy. On September 18, Donna will perform all of Ann's painting-inspired compositions, give brief commentaries, and show specific paintings that inspired each piano composition.

Donna Mulzet Beech has been Music Director at LBPC since September 1987, serving as organist, pianist, and choir director. On the keyboard faculty of The Music School of Delaware since 1979, Donna is part of the Master Faculty with Distinction. She maintains an independent studio where she offers instruction in piano, music theory, and composition, and is active as an accompanist for professionals and students alike. Donna is an active member of the PA Music Teachers Association, and is President-Elect for the DE Music Teachers Association. She earned her Doctorate of Musical Arts degree in 1990 from The Catholic University of America, and bachelor's and master's degrees in music from West Chester University. In 2008 Donna established the Jonathan Beech Memorial Concert, an annual benefit in memory of her older child who died of a brain tumor in 2007; to date these concerts have raised over \$161,000 for organizations that help children and families dealing with pediatric cancer. Donna resides in Kennett Square with her violinist husband Martin.




