A special service of remembrance, including the unveiling of a bronze plaque commemorating our 300th anniversary.

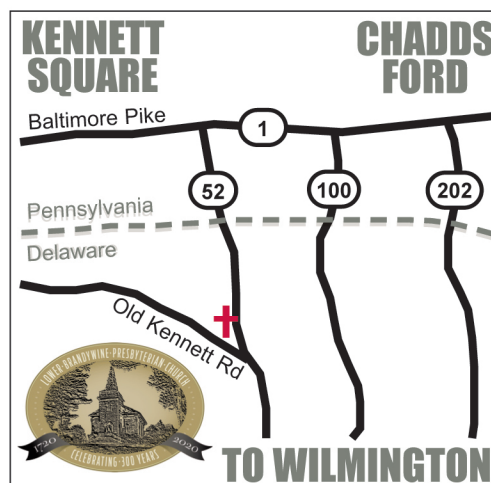

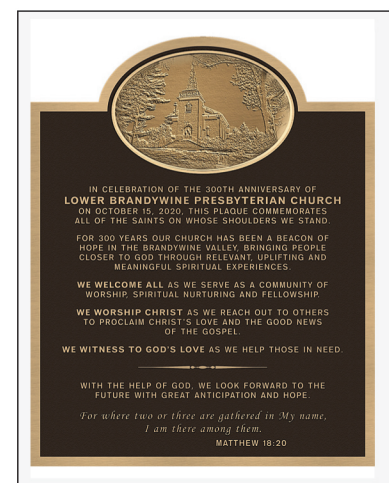
