We'll gather for worship, bible study and reflection, the rituals of ashes and communion, and other special events as we explore the blessings of **Digging Deeper**.


## Digging Deeper Speakers

**Ash Wednesday Supper and Service, March 22**

**6:00pm Lenten Supper** in the Social Hall

**6:45pm Reflection and Receiving of Ashes** in the Sanctuary  
*With the mark of the ashes, Lent begins. We are reminded as we receive this symbol that we are mortal, as it says in Genesis 3:19: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." A ritual of penitence, humility, a seeking after forgiveness and healing, the ashes will begin our journey of digging deeper.*

**Palm Sunday Worship, April 2 | 10:00am** in the Sanctuary  
*Hosanna! Children will start the service with a palm processional.*

**Maundy Thursday Meal, April 6 | 7:00pm** in the Social Hall  
*Gathered around tables, as the first disciples gathered with Jesus in the upper room, we share a simple meal followed by communion as we recall the Last Supper.*

**Good Friday Tenebrae, April 7 | 7:00pm** in the Sanctuary  
*Often called the Service of Shadows, the music and readings take us into the last events of Jesus' life. Come to sit by the cross, to pray, to reflect on the meaning of these events for you and for the world.*

**Easter Sunday Worship, April 9 | 10:00am** in the Sanctuary  
*Celebration of Easter featuring the Flowering of the Cross and festive Brass Quartet.*
